Abstract (en)

[origin: EP1199728A2] The isolated electrical conductor has a metal conductor (1), a first coating containing glass and/or mica and a second plastic coating (6) over the first coating. The first coating consists of at least two bands (2,3) of glass and/or mica applied to the conductor, whereby the width of the strips is selected so that they overlap by at least 50 per cent. Independent claims are also included for the following: an arrangement for implementing the method of manufacturing an isolated electrical conductor that retains functionality in event of fire.
