Abstract (en)
[origin: EP1316265A1] Sports shoe, especially a ski shoe, comprises a shell part (3), a sleeve pivotally fixed on the shell part, and a step element (22) forming bearing surfaces on opposite-lying end regions of the shell part and provided with coupling protrusions (27). The step element is fixed on the shell part in the center relative to the central longitudinal axis (41) via a base element having a clamping and fixing arrangement. The coupling protrusion of the step element protrudes over the shell part asymmetrically relative to the central longitudinal axis. <?>An Independent claim is also included for a step element for a sports shoe. Preferred Features: An axis of symmetry (42) extending through the coupling protrusion runs at an angle to the central longitudinal axis. The step element is provided with a non-slip, wear-resistant coating forming the bearing surface.
