[origin: EP1386643A1] An object of the present invention is to provide a snowboard and a ski whose edges are not released easily even when being strongly engaged and which are easy to operate. <??>In the snowboard and the ski, left and right upper edges are respectively provided above left and right sole edges so as to protrude more to both the left and right sides than the left and right sole edges. When the board is greatly tilted, a snow surface can be caught by both the sole edge and the upper edge, and even when the sole edge is released, the snow surface can be caught, by the upper edge. <IMAGE>
