Abstract (en)
[origin: EP1400227A1] Rescue stretcher, designed for all types of rescue operations in high and middle mountains and ravines. The stretcher is characterized in that it is formed by a base or structure (1), which can be folded and separated into two different parts. It is fitted with protective elements for the head and feet areas and handles for manual transportation; an insulation blanket (2) that can be separated into independent parts; a fixing harness (3), horns (4) to carry the assembly on the shoulders and a protective and immobilizing element for the head (5). <IMAGE>
