Abstract (en)

[origin: EP1559850A2] A flooring panel (10) has interlocking edge profiles (2, 3) to secure the panels in both horizontal and vertical settings. The upper surface of the panels is provided with a decorative pattern and the edges are chamfered (20) to provide V-grooves between the panels. The chamfers and the interlocking profiles are protected by a melamine layer applied as impregnated paper or by direct coating, and heat cured. The chamfers are coloured to match or compliment the panel pattern. The design can be applied to flooring panels made of all types of materials.
