[origin: EP2289507A1] The invention provides pharmaceutical compositions comprising a cholesteryl ester transfer protein (CEPT) inhibitor and a water-insoluble concentration-enhancing additive, which exhibit improved bioavailability. The invention also provides methods of treating cardiovascular disorders comprising the administration of the pharmaceutical compositions comprising a CETP inhibitor.
