[origin: WO03042861A2] The invention relates to a method and a device for the computer-implemented production and administration of contracts between a supplier and at least one customer, each contract consisting of core data for a contractual product and of at least one contract element. Said core data is stored in a first memory unit and said contract elements are stored in a second memory unit. In order to draw up a contract, core data and contract elements are selected. The contract is electronically produced on the basis of this selection by means of automatic production and storage of electronic references (links) concerning the selected core data and contract elements.
