Abstract (en)
[origin: EP1610060A2] A retractable lighting device comprising at least one arm (20) bearing at least one lamp holder (21) and at least one light bulb (22) and positioned above a structure to be illuminated (12, 13) wherein said arm (20) is linked to a mobile support element (17) by means of an alternative actuator (24, 31) that controls the movement between a rest position, wherein the complete lighting device is contained in a plane support (14) within said structure (12, 13) and a working position external to said structure (12, 13) when the light bulb is lit up. Therefore movement can be made on either a horizontal or vertical plane, as well as on the exterior of the structure or in an internal position covered of the said structure.
