[origin: WO2004091951A1] The invention relates to a device for preventing blinding effects on vehicle or machine drivers in flexible positions which, however, results in a significant restriction in the field of vision and/or for use as a medium for presenting visual information. In order to correct for a restriction in the field of vision and to use the shade as a medium for presenting visual information, the light/sun shade is made of transparent materials and comprises an integrated information system.
