Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2004109631A1] The invention relates to a net (1), in particular a net used for volleyball, football, tennis or net-type fencing, comprising a net body (4) consisting of net strings (2) that are interconnected in a mesh. Said net body (4) comprises a mesh (6) with an opening width (W), which essentially permits unrestricted vision through the net body (4). Said net is characterised in that the net strings (2) of the net body (4) are thickened in a region (8) extending over a section of the mesh (6) by a material (10) in the form of a fibrous material applied by flocking, or a self-expanding plastic material applied by spraying, in such a way that the region (8) can be recognised from the exterior as a sign (14) that is outlined against the net body (4), said sign consisting in particular of characters or a logo.
