[origin: WO2005037246A2] Disclosed are sterile aqueous preparations that are to be inhaled as an aerosol and contain an active substance, a nonionic surfactant, and a phospholipid. Said preparations are suitable for administering poorly soluble active substances by way of inhalation in the form of colloidal solutions and can also be used for administering bad-tasting active substances that irritate the mucus and cause cough or bronchoconstrictions. The inventive preparations can be nebulized by means of conventional devices and are preferably used in pediatrics.
