[origin: US2005218198A1] Dispensers for comestible products are provided. The dispensers can be made of any suitable material including paperboard and plastic. The dispensers in general open to expose multiple products to the consumer who can select one or more of same. The dispensers are recloseable and can be pseudo-airtight. They can be sized to hold varying amounts and sizes of products. In certain embodiments, glue or adhesive is used to hold the products in place.
