Abstract (en)  
A safety road furniture element, adapted to enhance road safety characteristics for pedestrians and drivers of automotive vehicles, motor vehicles, bicycles and any other means going along the road itself. In particular, such element comprises an elongated angular structure (10), made of elastic plastic and impact-resistant material, adapted to cover the pavement kerbs, in order to deaden and soften impacts by things and/or people; the visible surfaces (12, 13) of the angular structure (10) foresee the insertion of refractive delineators (16), positioned inside appropriate seats (11), refractive adhesive tapes (17) and/or luminous LED diodes (20), powered by batteries, rechargeable by way of appropriate photovoltaic cells (18), the latter also inserted inside the angular structure (10).
