Abstract (en)
[origin: GB2416689A] A collapsible chair (10), has a frame assembly (12) defining a seat squab (12) which may be padded, a backrest (19) which may be adjustable to recline and may also be padded. A plurality of height adjustable legs (14) are attached to the frame and move with respect to the frame to allow use of the seat on uneven ground. The legs may be attached via the use hingeable leg brackets (16). The legs may have load spreading feet / pads (18) attached to the base of them. In use the upper portion of the legs extend above the upper face of the frame and may be used to attach an accessory, via the use of a clamp (22), such as a tray (24). The device may be collapsed for transportation, see figure 8.
