Abstract (en)
[origin: EP1624108A1] The paving block (1) has sides (23) extending at right angles to the road surface, and interlocking elements (3,4) on the sides, to engage with similar elements of a neighboring block. At least one element is of a width, which corresponds mainly to the space (5) between two neighboring elements of a neighboring block. Two opposite sides each have the same number of wide interlocking elements diametrically opposite to each other. At least one element has a buffer bag, and at least one lower edge (24) of a side is sharp. At least one space between two elements has a raised part. One element (3) projects to act as spacer.
