Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2006092414A1] The invention relates to 5,6-dialkyl-7-amino-azolopyrimidines of formula (I), in which the substituents are defined as follows: R₁-represents haloalkyl, haloalkoxyalkyl, alkoxyhaloalkyl, alkenyl, haloalkenyl, alkynyl or haloalkynyl; R₂-represents alkyl, alkoxyalkyl, alkenyl or alkynyl, where R₁ and/or R₂ can be substituted as per the description; A represents N or CH; and R₃-represents CH₂-CH₂- and if A represents CH additionally hydrogen. The invention also relates to a method and intermediate products for producing said compounds, to agents containing the latter and to the use of the compounds for controlling plant pathogenic fungi.
