[origin: EP1859765A2] It is about a wheelchair for rehabilitation able to increase the level of the seat (8) and to verticalize (9,8,10), that simultaneously with its adjustments 'of level provide to enlarge the front wheels (6) so that they are free to orientate without interfere with the supporting device (10) of the footplates and the same footplates (11), receding from the outside advanced position in the space defined by the laying of the wheels (5,6) to the ground.
