[origin: WO2008020053A2] Process for fractionating a hydrocarbonaceous catalytically cracked product stream comprising: a) passing said product stream to a vertical fractionation column through an inlet; b) redirecting a part of the product stream upon entering the fractionation column upwards into the fractionation column by using a baffle; c) separating the product stream into one or more hydrocarbonaceous fractions; and d) discharging the fractions from the fractionation column.
