[origin: WO2009046766A1] The roof window comprises: at least a main frame (1), associated to a relative opening (7) afforded in a roof; means for closing (2), at least partially obstructing the opening (7); operating organs (3), cooperating with the main frame (1) and with the means for closing (2), for enabling movement of the means for closing (2) between a closed position (C), in which the means for closing (2) and the main frame (1) are at least partially in reciprocal contact, and a completely open position (A), in which at least respective portions of the means for closing (2) and the main frame (1) are distanced from one another.
