[origin: EP2233020A1] A composite shoe includes detachably coupled first and second shoe bodies. The second shoe body (20), which is a close-toed and close-heeled shoe, is received in and coupled with the first shoe body (10), which is a close-toed and open-heeled shoe, so that an outer bottom surface of a sole of the second shoe body lies on a surface of an insole (12) of the first shoe body while the second shoe body has a close-toed portion inserted in a close-toed portion of the first shoe body and a close-heeled portion disposed at an open-heeled portion of the first shoe body.
