[origin: WO2009124729A1] The invention relates to a sports shoe, in particular a tennis shoe, comprising an outsole surface made of an elastically shapeable material. According to the invention, the outsole surface is divided into the region of the heel, the forefoot and a connecting region that joins said regions. An energy absorbing element is integrated into the region of the heel.
