Abstract (en)

The cap of the present invention is adapted to cap a cup. The cap is formed with an opening (10), which has a first side (11) and a second side (12). A pressing plate (20) is extended from the first side (11) toward the second side (12), and the pressing plate (20) is swayable about the first side (11). The pressing plate (20) has a distal end, from which a cutting rim (21) is extended downward. The cutting rim (21) is adapted to cut a film when the cap is in use and when the pressing plate (20) is pressed downward. Thereby, the user can easily drink the contents in the cup via the opening (10).
