Abstract (en)  
Modular holding structure (100) for ground surfacing (102), such as a floor, a stone surfacing or a pavement, said structure comprising a plurality of unitary modules (10) connected together in order to design a flat holding able to be placed vertically between the ground and the surfacing, in which structure each module (10) is a plate having a polygonal periphery which is bounded by a horizontal superior planar face (12) and by several vertical side faces (16), each side face (16) being provided with consecutive and complementary tenons (40) and mortises (42) designed in order to allow the connection of two adjacent unitary modules (10) through fitting along the vertical direction (V) wherein at least some tenons (40) protrude vertically (44) above the surface of said superior horizontal face (12) of the plate.
