Abstract (en)
[origin: WO2010116226A2] The invention relates to an eyeglass holder for detachably holding eyeglasses (2; 102; 402) on an article of clothing (7; 107; 407; 607) of a user, comprising holding means (5, 6, 105; 106; 405; 406), which are intended to be associated with the article of clothing (7; 107; 407; 607), and comprising a magnetic or ferromagnetic element (6; 106; 406) and a coupling element made of magnetic material (5, 105, 405), which are capable of attraction by means of magnetic interaction, wherein the holding means (5, 6) engage with the article of clothing by interposition of at least one clothing layer (7; 107; 407; 607) of the article of clothing between the magnetic or ferromagnetic element (8) and the connecting element (5). According to the invention, the eyeglass holder comprises a securing and connecting thread (4; 104; 204; 304, 404) between the holding means (5, 6) and one of the sidepieces (3; 103; 403) of the eyeglasses, an element (10; 110; 210; 310; 410; 510; 610) that is hollow throughout and that is crossed by the securing and connecting thread (4; 104; 204; 304; 404; 504; 604) in the direction of the sidepiece (3; 103; 403), which securing and connecting thread is bent to form a loop (8; 108; 208; 308; 408; 508; 608), which encircles the sidepiece (3; 103; 403) and can be fastened to the body (10; 110; 210; 310; 410; 510; 610) that is hollow throughout, and clamping means (15; 115; 215; 315; 317; 415; 513; 615) for detachably fastening the securing and connecting thread (4; 104; 204; 304; 404; 504; 604) to the element (10; 110; 210; 310; 410; 510; 610) that is hollow throughout.
