Abstract (en)
The object has an ornamental body (2) and a supporting body detachably coupled with one another by magnets (3), locking pins (5) and locking grooves. Quarter-turn rotation or full-turn rotation is performed for fixing the locking pins of the ornamental body relative to the supporting body. The locking pins and the locking grooves are used for providing a bayonet connection or a screw connection. A pin (8) is engaged in a recess of the supporting body. The pin is equipped with a sleeve (9), where the sleeve surrounds one of the magnets.

Abstract (de)
Die vorliegende Erfindung betrifft einen Schmuckgegenstand, welcher mit einem Tragkörper (1) und mit einem Zierkörper (2) ausgerüstet ist. Der Zierkörper (2) ist magnetisch und zusätzlich mechanisch lösbar mit dem Tragkörper (1) verbunden. Erfindungsgemäß ist zur mechanisch lösbaren Verbindung eine Dreh-/Steckverbindung (5, 6) vorgesehen.
