Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2011015784A1] The invention relates to a device for dispensing wiping material, including the wiping material and an apparatus for dispensing said material, characterized in that the wiping material (1) includes, over the entirety or a portion of the length thereof, a marking area (1a) having imprints appearing on the front and back of the material and placed and arranged so as to ensure a meshing function, and in that the dispensing apparatus (D) includes a mechanism having a pressing means that is arranged and profiled with an imprint (2a) in a shape that is complementary to the imprints (1a) formed on the material, and in that the imprints (1a-2a) formed on the material (1) and the pressing means (2) of the mechanism of the apparatus provide a mechanical drive function by means of meshing, and in that the pressing means of said mechanism operates when loading the material strip and is then deactivated.
