Abstract (en)
[origin: WO2011079328A1] For a road arrangement (1), comprising a roadway structure (2) that forms a roadway (20) at least in some sections, wherein the roadway structure (2) has a first edge (21) at the surface on one side, said first edge substantially following a road course of the road arrangement (1), and wherein the road arrangement (1) comprises an installation surface (3) for installing prefabricated protective wall elements (6), said installation surface substantially following the course of the first edge (21) and being arranged next to the roadway (20), according to the invention, in order to reliably and cost-effectively produce and maintain the road arrangement on site and to ensure the small deflection of a protective wall element (6) installed on the installation surface, the road arrangement (1) comprises an elongated support element (4), said elongated support element (4) in particular being cast in concrete on site and arranged adjacent to a side (31) of the installation surface (3) facing away from the roadway (20), and a stop surface (41) for limiting a deflecting motion of a protective wall element (6) installed on the installation surface is formed on the support element (4).
