Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2011095190A1] The invention relates to a blister packaging (3) for sanitary insert parts or accessory parts (4, 5, 6). Said sanitary insert or accessory parts (4, 5, 6) can be interchanged with each other or combined with each other. Each of said sanitary insert parts or accessory parts (4, 5, 6) is arranged in a mold cavity (8) of a molded plastic-film part (7) made from transparent plastic. Because said insert parts or accessory parts (4, 5, 6) that can be interchanged with each other or combined with each other are accommodated in a single blister packaging (3), the correct association of said parts (4, 5, 6) is ensured and the handling of said parts (4, 5, 6) is made easier even for the uninformed user. Because insert parts that can be combined with each other if necessary can also be packaged with each other in the blister packaging (3) according to the invention, the parts (4, 5, 6) initially not required to assemble the desired parts combination can be stored in the blister packaging (3) according to the invention in a protected manner and in such a way that said parts can be easily found again (see Fig. 3).
