Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2013072172A2] The invention relates to hair treatment compositions which comprise one or more cationic care substances and one or more particular UV filters, and also to the methods for cleansing and/or caring for hair, using these compositions. Hair treatment compositions which combine enhanced care effects, more particularly enhanced combability, softness and gloss of the hair, with a stability of their viscosity over wide temperature ranges, comprise - based on their weight - 0.1 to 20 weight % of at least one UV filter and also 0.1 to 30 weight % of at least one compound of the general formula (I) in which n and m independently of one another stand for whole numbers between 5 and 40, with the proviso that  $n + m \geq 38$ ; a and b independently of one another stand for whole numbers between 1 and 10; R and R' independently of one another are selected from -H and -CH<sub>3</sub>; and X- is a physiologically tolerated anion.
