Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2013092494A2] The invention relates to a detergent solution pump-out section (14) for a domestic appliance (1) for the care of laundry items, comprising a pump-out hose (15) that is in some sections configured as a corrugated pipe and integrally comprises an aeration device (21) having an aeration opening (22) that is formed on a jacket side (20) of the pump-out hose (15), and comprising a drain element (17) having a drain connector (24), the drain element being attachable in the area of the aeration opening (22) to the jacket side (20) of the pump-out hose (15), wherein the drain element (17) is a rectilinear single-piece clip made of plastic. The invention further relates to a domestic appliance (1) for the care of laundry items that has a detergent solution pump-out section (14).
