[origin: EP2842448A2] A method for coloring hair is described, which includes using traditional professional instruments and utilizing hair dyes available on the market, comprising dividing, on the head of an individual, the mass of hair into a plurality of sections (1-4) to be treated individually, coloring the hair starting from a first section (1) of the head continuing with the next remaining sections (2-4) using said traditional professional instruments, said traditional professional instruments comprising at least one brush (6, 10, 60).
