Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2013182185A1] The invention relates to a joining system for detachably fastening components, in particular for shopfitting, having a longitudinal component (103, 103'), which has at least two undercut-like openings (106) extending offset with respect to one another in the circumferential direction, having a joining element (110) which has fastening means that can engage in the opening (106) of the component (103, 103'), wherein the joining element (110) has further fastening elements for fixing to a further component (103, 103'), wherein the joining element (110) comprises a plug socket (112) which runs perpendicularly to the longitudinal component (103, 103') and from which a fixing element (113) protrudes in the transverse direction, the fixing element being designed in such a manner that it can be inserted in a first insertion position into the opening (106) and by turning can be brought into a second fixed position in which the joining element (110) is held clamped against the longitudinal component (103, 103').
