[origin: WO2015032446A1] The invention relates to a method for decontaminating contaminated water, the contaminated water being pumped and further processed. The contaminated water, after being pumped, is mixed with a liquid decontaminating agent and then filled into a preferably floating plastics container located in the water, the plastics container then remaining in the water. The invention also relates to a plastics container therefor.
