Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2015074973A1] The invention relates to a device and method for balancing fluids for an extracorporeal blood treatment device comprising a blood treatment unit. The device according to the invention and method according to the invention are based on the monitoring of an inner fluid system I, which comprises the blood treatment unit (8), and an outer fluid system, which supplies the inner fluid system with fresh fluid and/or removes waste liquid from it. The balancing device according to the invention, has a monitoring device A, which comprises a processing unit (27), which is configured such that the volume, or a variable of the liquid (8) correlated with the volume, which is supplied to a balancing unit (8) is compared with the volume or with the volume-correlated variable of the liquid to be removed from the balancing unit. On the basis of the ratio of the volume or of the volume-correlated variable of the fluid supplied to or removed from the balancing unit (8), an incorrect balancing will be identified.
