[origin: WO2015092314A1] The present invention relates to a wound-filling composite material including a casing containing a material or set of materials forming fluid flow channels. Said casing is made up of an unwoven material formed from a mixture of bicomponent superabsorbent fibers and thermobonding absorbent fibers. Said bicomponent superabsorbent fibers are of the core/shell type. Said core is made of polyacrylonitrile, and the shell is made of polyacrylate.
