Abstract (en)

The present invention relates to a device for securing and supporting a stack of plastic bags. The device comprises an elongated support member (16) formed of a plastic material, said member having a forward side (18) and an aft side (20); at least two fastening means (30; 62) for plastic bags arranged on the aft side of the elongated support member; and at least one attachment element (50; 60; 70) extending from the support member and intended to be connected to a corresponding holder for the device and the plastic bags. The invention furthermore relates to a garbage collecting device comprising said device.
