Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2016150863A1] The invention relates to a contacting device (1) for contacting an electrical conductor (10) to an electrical conductor path (20), comprising a housing (100) having a hollow chamber (104), into which the electrical conductor (10) and the electrical conductor path (20) can be inserted. The contacting device (1) furthermore comprises a contact bridge (200) having a first section (210), which is arranged in the hollow chamber (104) of the housing, and a second section (220). The electrical conductor (10) can be clamped directly to the electrical conductor path (20) by means of the first section (210) of the contact bridge (200). Furthermore, the contacting device (1) can be fastened to an element of the electrical component (2) by means of the second section (220) of the contact bridge (200) to provide the electrical conductor path (20).
