Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2018127653A1] Footwear item (1) comprising • - an upper (2) provided with a foot opening (3), • - an inner lining (5) of the upper (2), • - tape arranged around said opening (3), • - at least one male element (7) of a press stud, each male element (7) being able to engage with at least one female press stud element fitted to an accessory (14) of said footwear item (1), the tape is a hidden tape arranged between the upper (2) and the lining (5), and is adhesively bonded with its outer face to the upper (2), the tape and the upper (2) are provided with holes (11), each male press stud element (7) passes through the tape and the upper (2) at a hole (11) and each male element (7) comprises, in one piece, a base (8), a generally spherical head (9) and a body connecting the head (9) to the base, said base being a hidden base positioned flat against the internal face of the tape and the head (9) of the male element (7) extending proud of the outer face (23) of the upper (2), the base of this head (9) being provided with a setback.
