Abstract (en)  
[origin: WO2018189465A1] The ironing appliance (2) comprises an iron (3), a steam chamber (17), an electric pump (5) configured to supply the steam chamber (17) with liquid, an electronic board (32) configured to control the electric pump (5), and an activation trigger (33) connected to the electronic board (32) so as to send an activation signal to the electronic board (32) representing an activation state of the activation trigger (33) or a release state of the activation trigger (33). The electronic board (32) is configured to control the electric pump (5) so as to supply the steam chamber (17) with a supply flow greater than 160 g/min for a supply duration of less than 2 seconds when an activation signal corresponding to an activation state of the activation trigger (33) is sent to the electronic board (32) after an activation trigger (33) release period of more than 4 seconds.
