Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2019086467A1] The invention relates to a module for a modular, motorised drive system (100), in particular for doors, wherein the modular system (100) is designed such that a number of modules (100) arranged linearly one behind the other along a longitudinal axis (LA) of the modular system (100) form a functional group (170) of the drive system (200). The modular system (100) comprises a number of latching elements (110) on a front side (101) of the module (100) orthogonal to the longitudinal axis (LA) and/or a number of receiving elements (120), which are complementary to the latching elements (110), on a rear side (102) of the module (100) orthogonal to the longitudinal axis (LA) and opposite the front side (101), wherein the receiving elements (120) are designed to form a mechanical connection to the latching elements (110) of a further module (100) which is arranged with its front side (101) parallel to the rear side (102) of the module (100). The invention also relates to a modular, motorised drive system (200), in particular for doors, wherein a number of modules (100) arranged linearly one behind the other along a longitudinal axis (LA) of the modular system (100), in particular according to the invention, forms a functional group (170) of the drive system (200), and to an use of the drive system (200) for actuating a door, in particular a vehicle door. The invention further relates to a production method (300) for a modular, motorised, in particular inventive, drive system (200), in particular for doors.
