[origin: CN111688554A] The invention relates to a child seat (1) for a motor vehicle, comprising an indicator device (5; 51, 10) for indicating the correct interaction of an Isofix locking device (2) of a child seat (1) with an Isofix connection member of a motor vehicle, wherein a joystick (4) is arranged on the child seat in order to release an Isofix locking device (2) arranged in the child seat by means of a cable pulling device (21), wherein the joystick (4) pivots a cam (6) mounted in the child seat directly or indirectly from a locked position to a released position, wherein a pulling cable of the cable pulling device (21) is fixed on an arm (61) of the cam (6); when the pulling cable pivots the cam (6), the Isofix locking device (2) is released by pulling the pulling cable, and the Isofix connection withthe automobile is released; wherein, in the locked position, the cam (6) acts with its arm (61) on a lever (51) arranged in the child seat and rotatable about an axis, and in the locked position, thefree end facing away from the cam (52) of the lever is visible from the outside through an opening (10) in the housing (3) of the child seat (1), but in the released position, the lever pivots away from the opening.
