[origin: WO2019137862A1] A hydraulic machine (1) having a housing interior space (30) and having a group (16) of hydrostatic working chambers which are mounted in said housing interior space so as to be rotatable about an axis of rotation (18) and which, as the group rotates, are connectable alternately to a high pressure and to a low pressure of the hydraulic machine and exhibit leakage into the housing interior space, wherein a heat exchanger device (36) is accommodated in the housing interior space (30). A hydraulic assembly and a hydraulic axle, each having a hydraulic machine of said type, are also disclosed.
