Abstract (en)

A modular furniture system (1) for providing a wide variety of furniture. It comprises a number of modular elements (2), each module element (2) comprises a first substantially flat surface (3) and an opposite placed second surface (4). The second surface (4) and the side-surfaces (5,6,7,8) are essentially plane. The module elements (2) are provided in a flexible material. Further, the modular furniture system (1) comprises a frame surrounding a square or rectangular cavity (11) bounded by the frame (10). The frame is configured to receive and fix the module elements (2) in a defined position for providing the furniture. Both the frame (10) and the module elements (2) are provided in a foam rubber material.
