Abstract (en)

[origin: WO2019162523A1] The invention relates to an umbrella handle (1) for a portable umbrella comprising a receiving means (2.1) for an umbrella pole and a receiving means (2.4) for at least one electronic circuit, wherein, in addition, an electronic circuit (4) having a voltage supply (4.4) and an output unit for sound (7) are arranged in the umbrella handle (1), and the umbrella handle (1) has a receiving part (2), wherein the receiving part (2) provides a receiving means (2.1) for an umbrella pole, a receiving means (2.4) for at least one electronic circuit, and a receiving means (2.5) for an umbrella release unit. The invention also relates to an automatic umbrella. The object of the invention, to provide an easily assembled and cost-effective umbrella handle for a portable umbrella having a playback option for sound, which simultaneously permits improved and simplified operability, is achieved for an umbrella handle in that the umbrella release unit comprises at least one operating element (5), with which the umbrella is released and the at least one electronic circuit (4) can be controlled, and the electronic circuit (4) has at least one switch (4.1), wherein the at least one operating element (5) comprises a control means (5.3) designed for mechanically triggering the at least one switch (4.1). The object of the invention is also achieved via an automatic umbrella comprising an umbrella handle according to the invention.
