Abstract (en)
[origin: CA3101647A1] The invention relates to a wiper plate (1) comprising a main body (2) to which a first wiper plate wing (3) and a second wiper plate wing (4) are pivotably connected, the wiper plate wings (3, 4) being reversibly fixable in a working position (6) by means of a fixing device (5), the fixing device (5) comprising a foot pedal (7), the fixing device (5) being released by actuating the foot pedal (7) so that the wiper plate wings (3, 4) can be pivoted from the working position (6) into a wringing-out position (8), the foot pedal (7) being pivotably mounted on the first wiper plate wing (3), and the foot pedal (7) fixing the second wiper plate wing (4) in the working position (6), wherein the foot pedal (7) has spring means which are designed such that the second wiper plate wing (4) pivots relative to the first wiper plate wing (3) when the foot pedal (7) is actuated.
