[origin: WO2020079363A1] A support (10) for attaching an accessory (30) for decorating or embellishing a person's body, the accessory (30) comprising an object (32) to which a magnetised base (34) is attached, the support (10) comprising a solid substrate (12) having an adhesive back face (14) configured to adhere to a part of the body (22), and a magnetic compound (16) attached to the substrate (12) and configured to hold the accessory (30) removably on the support (10).
