[origin: WO2020079531A1] The invention relates to acyl-N-methylglucamide(s) and an oral care composition containing acyl-N-methylglucamide(s) for use in a method of treating caries by reducing the lactic acid release of lactic acid producing bacteria in an oral biofilm in the mouth of a human being or animal. The invention also relates to a kit of parts for use in a method of treating caries by reducing the lactic acid release of lactic acid producing bacteria in an oral biofilm, the kit of parts comprising Part A comprising certain acyl-N-methylglucamide(s) or mixtures thereof, Part B comprising water, and optionally Part C comprising an application device.
