Abstract (en)
[origin: WO2020121160A1] The invention relates to a hygienic article product, which comprises: a plurality of hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads intended to be inserted into underpants, on the rear side of each of which hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads at least one adhesive layer having at least one covering strip that can be pulled off of the at least one adhesive layer is provided; and packaging for the hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads. According to the invention, the hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads are not packaged individually, and the packaging is a reclosable film packaging and/or paper packaging based on paper tissue packaging, in which film packaging and/or paper packaging the hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads are inserted lying one over the other in a stack and from which film packaging and/or paper packaging the hygienic inserts and/or sanitary pads can be removed individually like paper tissues, and the film packaging and/or paper packaging has a reclosable opening on each of the narrow sides of the film packaging and/or paper packaging lying opposite one another.
