Abstract (en)
[origin: WO2020229556A1] The invention relates to an incontinence article (2) for absorbing bodily excretions, wherein, on the stomach portion (4) or the back portion (6), a first identification means (70) is provided in a first region (11), and the first identification means (70) has a first identifier (72), which is formed by a coloured zone (73) extending over a surface area and provides a first piece of information, wherein the coloured zone (73) can be visually distinguished from a second region (13) surrounding it, wherein a second, batch-individualizing identification means (90) is provided in the stomach portion (4) or back portion (6) having the first identification means (70), in a predetermined spatial arrangement in relation to the first identification means (70).
