Abstract (en)

[origin: CN217578265U] The utility model relates to a device for sealing a container with a container sealing piece, in particular to a device for sealing a beverage container with a container sealing piece in beverage filling equipment, which comprises a transportation unit capable of moving in the transportation direction, and the transportation unit is provided with a sealing unit capable of moving at the transportation unit transversely to the transportation direction. The utility model relates to a closure unit for selectively applying a first closure type to a container opening of a first container type and a second closure type to a container opening of a second container type, in which a guide cam for specifying a position of the closure unit transverse to the transport direction engages with the closure unit, wherein the guide cam comprises a first guide section for guiding the closure unit to apply a first closure type and a second guide section, which lies behind the first guide section in the transport direction, for guiding the closure unit to apply a second closure type.
